The connection between the Mass and the Passover meal is important for us to understand. The meal on Wednesday in Holy Week (16th April) is not to celebrate a Passover Meal itself, but for us to experience how the form in which we celebrate Mass derives from the meal that was the Last Supper. 50th Anniversary of the closure of Notre Dame Convent School. The Notre Dame Convent School in Abington St. in Northampton town centre, sadly closed in 1975 and pupils were moved to a new purpose built mixed R.C. school, and the beloved building and chapel were destroyed, and the grounds built over - with only the Sister's Cemetery left as a reminder of their presence. A Mass to mark the Sister's historic role in providing a Catholic education to Northampton school girls and the closure of the Convent School, is being held at the Cathedral on Saturday 19th July at 12noon. It will be followed by a reception in the St. Thomas Centre, allowing former pupils to meet up, and reminisce. If you were a Notre Dame pupil or know someone who was, please come or let them know about the Mass.
