The connection between the Mass and the Passover meal is important for us to understand. The meal on Wednesday in Holy Week (16<sup>th</sup> April) is not to celebrate a Passover Meal itself, but for us to experience how the form in which we celebrate Mass derives from the meal that was the Last Supper. Tickets are £12 per person and will be on sale next week from Caryll Comley in the office at St. Gregory's church. Accompanied children are free, although donations for them will not be refused!
