A Year of Encounter: Using our Catholic voice in the general election. With the General Election fast approaching, CAFOD and St Vincent de Paul are inviting parishes to reach out to local candidates to find out more about their views on the issues that we, as people of faith, care about, such as poverty and injustice. Bishop David Oakley is available to meet with anyone affected by abuse, as a victim, survivor, their families or supporters, where private discussions can take place in a safe and non-judgmental environment.
