**Lourdes Candle and Petitions.** As in previous years, during this year's Sacred Heart Pilgrimage to Lourdes, we will light a large candle on behalf of the parishes to burn in the grotto at Lourdes. There is a card candle in the Sacred Heart porch; if parishioners would like us to pray for their family, friends or themselves at the candle service, please print the names of those for whom you would like us to pray clearly on the candle and we ask that you contribute £2 to go towards purchasing the candle in Lourdes. Money can be given to Colette, Gareth or Carmel Davies at the Sacred Heart Church, or alternatively put in an envelope in the box in the porch. We hope to be able to livestream the candle service on the Sacred Heart Facebook page, where the names of those on the candle will be read out and we will pray for them. Billing parishioners can put their money in an envelope with the names clearly printed and give this to Fr Brendan. We are also happy to take petitions to Lourdes to be placed in the grotto. Please put these in a sealed envelope and put them in the box in the porch or give them to Fr Brendan. Please do not put money in these envelopes!

**The Relic of St. Bernadette.** In September and October of this year, the relics of St Bernadette will journey on pilgrimage through England, Scotland and Wales for the first time. It is hoped that this event will enable people of all ages and backgrounds to experience the special gifts and charisms of Lourdes in a church or cathedral near them. The relics will be arriving in our own diocese on **Monday 10th October 2022 at 3pm**. The reliquary will be placed in front of the sanctuary in the cathedral for people to venerate, before leaving Northampton on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> October at 9am. During this time, the cathedral will be open from 7am until 10pm, with Mass being celebrated at various points during the day, as well as led rosaries. There will also be a number of priests hearing confessions in the cathedral during this time. Please do check the diocesan website closer to the time for a more detailed schedule of events.
